1. **ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE:** Arrival is between Noon - 8 pm on Sunday, Oct. 8th to get settled in your stalls. **No Early Arrivals Allowed!** Release time is following the show on Thursday, Oct. 12th. **Horses will be housed in the Horse barn #2 and will show in Sutherland Arena.**

2. **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:** Original or notarized copy of current negative Coggins test results must be provided for all horses.

3. **LIABILITY:** The Georgia National Fair will not be responsible for any loss, personal injury or damage to horses exhibited or for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost or destroyed or in any way damaged. Each exhibitor will be responsible for any injury that may be occasioned to any person or any animal or damage to any property while on the grounds by any horse owned or exhibited by him/her and shall indemnify the management against all while on the grounds by any horse owned or exhibited by him/her and shall indemnify the management against all legally established claims to damages of any kind or nature that may grow out of any injury occasioned by any horse owned or exhibited by him/her.

4. **PARKING & PASSES:** All vehicles pulling trailers with horses aboard will be allowed to enter the East Gate. Vehicle and admission passes will be issued upon arrival at the barn when stalling horses. One (1) complimentary vehicle pass and two (2) complimentary admission passes will be issued per exhibitor and must be picked up at the barn. Vehicles with vehicle passes may park in Lot 5 or 6. All other vehicles must park outside gates and all other personnel must purchase admission tickets at gate. When leaving the grounds, be sure to have your hand stamped at the gate to be able to return the same day without an additional charge. * **R.V. hookup reservations must be made with and fees paid directly to the Georgia National Fair. Reservations are available online only at www.gnfa.com/rv-reservation.**

Riders: WT/WJ Classes Cannot Cross Over to WTC/WJL

Definitions:

Age of Equine for competition purposes is considered to be one year old on the 1st day of January following the actual date of foaling.

Amateur is an individual that has reached his/her 18th birthday as of January 1st of the current competition year. An Amateur exhibitor does not receive monies/reimbursement for any type of horse training in any breed or discipline.

Trainer/Professional is any person who has the responsibility for the care, training, custody or performance of a horse. And, receives monies for services of training or riding of horses in any breed or discipline.

Youth is an individual who is 7 years old to - not reach his/her 18th birthday as of January 1st of the current competition year. A Youth exhibitor may NOT show a stallion in hand, or under saddle. Any Youth exhibitor anywhere on the show grounds while riding a horse is required to wear a helmet that is Equestrian ATSM/SEI approved. Green Horse is in its first year of showing at FHC, and should be exhibited by a trainer/professional or experienced handler/rider. i.e., Ride Green Jan 1 2016 - December 31 2016.

3. Decision of the Judge is Final. Respect to all Show Officials & Management is expected or Permanent REMOVAL From ALL FHC SHOWS is possible.

5. Gypsy Vanners must be registered in a Registry of the owner's choice, prior to the show. (See Rule Book)
6. Stall & Class Fees Must be Paid by Deadline. Post fee per class or stall will apply after deadline.
7. OPEN CHECK REQUIRED upon Arrival to ADD Classes – No Exceptions. **All Class Adds for the Day end at 12 Noon.**
8. **No Class Switching/Swapping after Deadline. No Refunds for Stalls, Classes, Shavings, Office Fee, Vendor Space, Catering, Advertising. No Refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, human or equine accidents, illness, or emergencies.**
