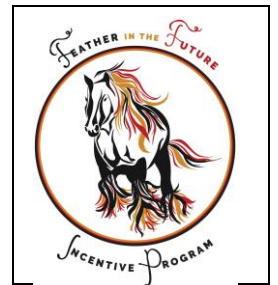

Utah section states that it is presumed that participants in equine or livestock activities are aware of and understand that there are inherent risks associated with these activities. Thus, an equine activity sponsor, equine professional, livestock activity sponsor, or livestock professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant due to the inherent risks associated with these activities. The section also requires an equine professional to give notice to participants of the limitation of liability, either by the posting of a sign or by the execution of a written release.

Definitions:

Age of Equine for competition purposes is considered to be one year old on the 1st day of January following the actual date of foaling.

Amateur is an individual that has reached his/her 18th birthday as of January 1st of the current competition year. An Amateur exhibitor does not receive monies/reimbursement for any type of horse training in any breed or discipline.

Trainer/Professional is any person who has the responsibility for the care, training, custody or performance of a horse. And, receives monies for services of training or riding of horses in any breed or discipline.

Youth is an individual who is 7 years old to - not reach his/her 18th birthday as of January 1st of the current competition year. A Youth exhibitor may NOT show a stallion in hand, or under saddle. Any Youth exhibitor anywhere on the show grounds while riding a horse **is required to wear a helmet that is Equestrian ATSM/SEI approved.**

- Show management reserved the Right to Cancel Combine any Classes as deemed Necessary.
- Decision of the Judge is Final. Respect to all Show Officials & Management is expected or Permanent REMOVAL from ALL FHC SHOWS is possible.

- All Horses must be registered in a Registry of the owner's choice prior to the show.
- Stall & Class Fees Must be Paid by Deadline. Post fee per class or stall will apply after deadline.
- OPEN CHECK REQUIRED upon Arrival to ADD Classes – No Exceptions. **All Class Adds for the Day end at 12 Noon.**
- No Class Switching/Swapping after Deadline. No Refunds for Stalls, Classes, Shavings, Office Fee, Vendor Space, Catering, Advertising. No Refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, human or equine accidents, illness, or emergencies.**

WARNING: (s§ 78-27b-103. Signs to be posted listing inherent risks and liability limitations.

- (3) The notice provided by the sign or document shall be sufficient if it includes the definition of inherent risk in Section 78-27b-101 and states that the sponsor is not liable for those inherent risks.
- (4) Notwithstanding Subsection (1), signs are not required to be posted for parades and activities that fall within Subsections 78-27b-101(2)(f) and (7)(c), (e), (g), (h), and (j).
